

Kingsbridge Cookworthy Museum: Visual Guide

Welcome to Kingsbridge Cookworthy Museum.

The museum is open Monday-Friday from 10:30am-3:30pm. Last entry is 30 mins before closing. The museum is normally open from the end of March until the end of October. See our visual guide to the museum for more information.

If you would like to do research the museum has a Local Heritage Resource Centre (LHRC) in the building. This has a separate entrance. It is open all year (bar 2 weeks at Christmas) by appointment.

PLEASE NOTE: the text information in this guide is correct at the time of writing (February 2025) but our exhibitions are changing and updated photographs will follow.



Getting to the Local Heritage Resource Centre (LHRC):

The LHRC is located at Kingsbridge Cookworthy Museum, 108 Fore Street, Kingsbridge. Postcode TQ7 1AW.

Public Transport:

From Plymouth: Stagecoach bus number 3. The bus stops opposite the museum if travelling from Plymouth.

From Dartmouth: Stagecoach bus no. 93.

From Salcombe:

Tally Ho bus number 606 or 164.

From Totnes:

Tally Ho bus number 164. The bus stops opposite the museum if travelling from Totnes.

By Car:

Kingsbridge Cookworthy Museum is located at 108 Fore Street TQ7 1AW. There is no car park at the museum. There is some on street parking directly outside the museum.

Directly outside the museum is 1 hour. Further up Fore Street it is 2 hours. There is one disabled space outside the museum. The nearest car park is Fore Street (TQ7 1PP) It is a one minute walk from the museum. There are 6 disabled spaces in this car park.

Local Heritage Resource Centre (LHRC):

There is a separate (and step free) entrance for our LHRC. It's a single red door, just up fore street from the main museum entrance. Lift and turn the large black handle to gain entry.

This is also the step free access to the museum, but please contact us in advance if you need step free access to the museum.

To access the LHRC once inside the building head along the ground floor corridor, turn right by the stairs and the LHRC will be in front of you.
